Week 3: "Your Will Be Done, On Earth As It Is In Heaven" (Ephesians 3:14-19)

Respond to this quote by R.C. Sproul: *Our chief end, our main purpose in our existence, our primary reason for being, is to glorify God. There's a bonus in that: as we glorify Him through obedience, we enjoy Him.*

Respond to this quote by Al Mohler: *Praying "your will be done on earth as it is in heaven" also reorients our own sense of personal autonomy and sense of control over our own lives and situations. This petition causes us to forfeit all our personal claims of lordship and sovereignty over our lives. This petition expresses a humble resignation to, and desire for, the reign and rule of God. It is no longer "my will" that is preeminent, but His.*

How does a proper understanding of the gospel message of grace help you give up trying to make "your will be done" and to rest in God's sovereign will?
