



## Sermon Reflection Questions

### **"Humbling Grace" (James 4:11-5:6)**

Chapter 4:11-12: In the eyes of the world, humility is often seen as a weak virtue. However, James seems convinced that we must remain humble to have a proper view of God and self. How does this truth apply to how we speak about others? What is one practical way you can avoid speaking ill of your brothers and sisters in Christ?

Chapter 4:13-17: If we trusted our future to God, what in our lives would look different? What anxieties would be relieved? Which worries would be new, if any?

Chapter 5:1-6 How does James' indictment of sinful practices with wealth challenge us? How can we take these warnings to heart as those who have been loved by Christ? How does our use of our money change when we realize that we are sinners saved by grace, no better than anyone else on our own? How can we use our wealth to demonstrate God's love for His people? How have we dishonored Christ with our money in the past?
