Sermon Reflection Questions **“Kind and Severe” (Romans 11:11-24)**

In what ways has God’s work in history stood out to you? How about in your own history?

What do you think of God’s use of “jealousy” to bring in believing Jews? Is there eternal hope for Jews in their Judaism alone?

How does this passage help us think about the future? In what ways will God act as He acted in the days of Paul? What do we have to look forward to as “the Israel of God?”

What does it mean that God is both “kind and severe?” Does this make us afraid? Does this make us humble?

How does Isaiah 19 help us understand Romans 11? How do these two passages in concert help us better understand the Gospel of grace at all? How does that understanding enrich how we ought to deal with other people?
